The system to be maintained is a React.js web app using the Semantic-UI framework with a backend API running on AWS (API Gateway, Lambda, DynamoDB). The code is well commented and lives in a Git repository on GitLab. AWS deployment is through Claudia.js

The suitable JavaScript Developer will be working for a leading but small charity making a big difference in environmental care in the UK. Ideally, we are seeking someone who is as passionate about the environment as they are about writing code.
